- Current SSWD board on hand; Don, Norm, Denis, Lisa & Jeff
- Article 1 Raise funds of ~\$1.9 million to replace water system, loan of ~\$1.5 million and grants of ~\$300k
  - Norm Champagne Accepts motion
  - Bob Buldoc 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Vote by secret ballot, start voting at 10:15am
- Article 2 Operating budget, presented by Lisa
  - o Go over 2023 budget and expenses
  - 2024 budget posted on pump house and emailed to everyone
    - +10% increase from last year due to inflation
    - \$16k to trust fund, rest to operating budget
  - Charlene Reinauer question: Phone bill went down on budget this year from last year, how come?
    - Norm answered: not sure why, will look into it
  - Budget will be posted to the SSWD portion of the Sunray Shores website
  - Ed Stephenson Accepts motion
  - Dave Reinauer 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Unanimous vote accepted
- Article 3 Capital reserve
  - Lisa: \$16k to capital reserve instead of the \$32k, because of repairs
  - Don: This will prevent SSWD from having to move money back & forth
  - o Norm: This will balance our budget, dues are now \$700 total
  - Sharon Hampton Accepts motion
  - Michelle Duval 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Unanimous vote accepted
- Article 4 Officers
  - Norm: 1 position open, 1 year commissioner (Denis was current)
  - o Ed Stephenson Nominate Denis Duval
  - Sharon Hampton 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Unanimous vote accepted
- Article 5 Presidents Report
  - Don: 2023 meeting minutes

- Ed Stephenson 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Unanimous vote accepted
- President's report
  - Vote on article 1 to get funding to replace water system
  - Horizon engineering working on it, phase 1 complete, with state for approval and working on permits
  - Tank going where current tank is located
  - Accommodations to add treatment, if necessary, in the future
  - Direct communication line from well to tank
  - Cameras installed by pump to catch evidence of vandalism
  - Dues going up \$70, annual fee is now \$700
  - Beaver deceiver water backed up by pumps state responsibility because of the sewer main
  - Physical address for SSWD 24 Pond Rd
    - Charlene Reinauer question: New system will have structure too?
      Yes.
    - Still have existing PO Box for mailing address
    - Good for IRS & Banks to have a physical address, PO Box doesn't always cut it or allowed
    - No mailbox at physical address

- Article 6 By Laws Norm presents the changes
  - Naming convention for officers to align with state names
  - Bills due on June 1<sup>st</sup> instead of July 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Consequences for not paying water bills
  - Everyone is current on water bills
  - Collection changes based on NH largest municipal water system rules
  - Charlene Reinauer question: stipend for treasurer?
    - Treasurer to get \$500, she's requesting \$1000 for treasurer since we're starting a big project and likely more work to be done in that role

  - Get in writing in the by-laws that the treasurer gets \$500
    - Tom Darragh motion to accept

- Beth Simpson question: who gets compensation
  - The board compensation is now 50% of the dues, not a set dollar amount (was \$300 previously)
- Charlene Reinauer motion to accept article 6
- Ed Stephenson 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Unanimous vote accepted
- New business
  - Kevin Walsh question: Thoughts on water conservation? Limiting yard watering?
    - Board will consider it if drought conditions it would be considered
    - New system will have data on how much water & usage (measurements)
    - Issues with not many full-time residents, maybe 50% full time
    - State issues water usage guidelines, maybe pass along to users
  - o Kevin Walsh question: Seasonal people, should their water be prorated?
    - Board will consider it would require a lot of changes, metering at each house, quite a bit more work for the board (maybe make it a paid board, currently volunteer board)
- Article 1 vote results: 76 voters, need 46 votes to pass
  - o 75 votes ves
  - o 1 vote no
  - Article 1 passes
